

4) The 3rd International Congress of Shoulder & Elbow Therapists (3rd ICSET) Martin Scott, Local ICSET Organiser

The 3rd ICSET will run parallel with the surgical programme, with synchronised timetables and open access between both conferences and a combined social programme. The organisers Martin Scott (UK), John Basti (USA) and Jo Gibson (UK) are pleased to present a broad and exciting programme with leading international researchers already confirmed to attend.

The programme will include case studies, free papers and invited speakers on topics including: the elbow, scapular dyskinesis, the kinetic chain, manual therapy, EMG evidence and rehab, neurovascular problems and pain.

Abstract submissions (including case studies) will be through the same system as the surgical conference.



5) Booking your Hotel accommodation for the ICSES 2010

The hugely popular Edinburgh International Festival ends on Saturday 4th September 2010 and the closing Military Tattoo is also on Saturday 4th September (see www.edinburghfestivals.co.uk/). Those attending should consider coming prior to the ICSES2010 Congress, including the last days of the International Festival. However more importantly, hotel accommodation in Edinburgh during the week from Monday 30th August to Saturday 4th September is at a premium – accommodation will need to be booked for this week well in advance and will be expensive unless you plan to book in to "Economy" hotels. Those who have already decided to come to Edinburgh during the week before ICSES 2010 should consider making their hotel bookings early i.e. now, to avoid disappointment.
